





CHAPTER ONE

1.0. INTRODUCTION

The Accounts of the Government of Ebonyi State of Nigeria for the year ended 31st December, 2019, have been audited under my direction in accordance with Section 125 Sub-Section 2 of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (as amended).

1.1. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ACCOUNTANT-GENERAL

In accordance with the provisions of Financial Instruction, the Accountant-General is responsible for the preparation of Financial Statements. The Accountant-General is the Chief Accounting Officer of the receipts and payments of Government of Ebonyi State. He is responsible for the general supervision of accounting activities in all Ministries and Departments within the State and for compilation of the Annual Financial Statements of Accounts and of such other Statements of Accounts as may be required by law. In doing this, he also has responsibilities for:

- Ensuring that all Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) keep proper books and records of accounts which disclose, with reasonable assurance and accuracy, the financial position of the State.
- > Taking such steps as are reasonably open to him to safeguard the assets of the State and to prevent and detect fraud and irregularities.
- Ensuring that in preparing the financial statements, he uses appropriate accounting policies consistently and supported by reasonable and prudent judgements and estimates and that all applicable accounting standards have been followed.

1.2. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE AUDITOR-GENERAL

The Auditor-General's responsibility is to express an independent opinion on the Financial Statements based on his audit in compliance with Section 125 Sub-Section 2 of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (as amended) which states that "the public accounts of a State and of all offices and courts of the State shall be audited by the Auditor-General for the State who shall submit his report to the House of Assembly of the State concerned and for that purpose, the Auditor-General or any person authorized by him in that behalf shall have access to all the books, records, returns and other documents relating to those accounts".

An Audit in this context involves the examination, on a test basis, of evidence relevant to the accounts and disclosures in the financial statements prepared by the Accountant-General. It also includes an assessment of the significant estimates and judgements made in the preparation of the Financial Statements and whether the accounting policies are appropriate to Government circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

CHAPTER TWO

2.0. GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

2.1. SUBMISSION OF THE 2019 FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

In accordance with the provisions of Section 125(5) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (as amended), the Financial Statements of the Government of Ebonyi State was submitted to me on 11th April, 2020. The statements submitted did not contain the Statement of Responsibility for the Financial Statements and the Statement of Significant Accounting Policies. These Statements were later submitted to me on 17th April, 2020 on my request.

2.2. ADJUSTMENT OF COUNTERPART FUNDS FROM RECURRENT TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURE

The release of **twenty-one million naira** (N21,000,000.00) as counterpart contribution to Donor Agency Assisted projects was classified as Recurrent Expenditure. I am of the opinion that counterpart contribution to projects should be classified as Capital Expenditure in subsequent year Financial Statements.

2.3. ADJUSTMENT TO OTHER RECURRENT EXPENSES

The inclusion of a recurrent expenditure subhead termed "Other Recurrent Expenses" lumped together different kinds of expenses thereby reducing the information available to users of the Financial Statements.

The Accountant-General was advised to report all expenses according to the subheads in subsequent Financial Statements in the spirit of IPSAS Accrual full disclosure requirements.

Items 2.2. and 2.3. were resolved and the Accountant-General effected the changes in the Financial Statements.

2.4. ISSUES RESOLVED AND ADJUSTED IN THE STATEMENT IN THE COURSE OF AUDIT

I had observed that the Internal Revenue Board did not include the Internally Generated Revenue (IGR) of four MDAs before uploading State IGR to the State website. This issue was resolved and the Accountant-General has effected the adjustments as necessary in the Financial Statements for the year under review.

CHAPTER THREE

3.0. STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE

3.1. INTERNALLY GENERATED REVENUE ON IPSAS ACCRUAL BASIS

Internally Generated Revenue (IGR) for the year ended 31st December, 2019 amounted to eleven billion, two hundred and thirty four million, three hundred and ninety-nine thousand, seventeen naira, forty four kobo (¥11,234,399,017.44). This represents 62.41% of the IGR Budget of eighteen billion naira (¥18,000,000,000.00) for the year.

The IGR budget performance according to revenue subheads is as detailed below:

Two subheads, 'Taxes' and 'Licences' surpassed revenue targets for the year yielding 155.89% and 215.19% of their budgets respectively. None of the revenue was classified as "Other Revenue" during the year as the subhead "Other Revenue" did not report any revenue for the year.

There is no budget for Re-imbursement which generated a total of forty-eight million, two hundred and ninety two thousand, five hundred and sixty-seven naira four kobo (N48,292,567.04) in the year.

Revenue generation for the other revenue subheads ranged from 5.95% for "Fines" to 68.97% for 'Fees' of budgeted figure for the year. Overall, most of the revenue subheads showed improvement against the performance for the year ended 31st December, 2018 such that the State IGR rose by 51.67% from seven billion, four hundred and seven million, two hundred and seventy seven thousand, two hundred and fifty one naira sixty seven kobo (\(\frac{1}{2}\)7,407,277,251.67) in 2018 to eleven billion, two hundred and thirty four million, three hundred and ninety-nine thousand, seventeen naira, forty four kobo (\(\frac{1}{2}\)11,234,399,017.44) in 2019.

The implication of the above is that MDAs from which the State Government expected revenue amounting to two billion ninety nine million, six hundred and sixty thousand, nine hundred sixty four naira (₹2,099,660,964.00) did not make any contribution to the revenue of the State.

It is doubtful if these MDAs can claim non collection of revenue in the year. Rather, the issue appears to be the non remittance of revenue generated to the Treasury Single Account.

The State needs to re-emphasize to MDAs the need to allow all State revenue to hit the TSA first. The Ministry of Finance and Economic Development should note this observation.

3.2. RECEIPTS FROM FAAC AND OTHER SOURCES OUTSIDE THE STATE GOVERNMENT

For the fiscal year ended 31st December, 2019 receipts from Federation Account Allocation Committee (FAAC) and other sources outside the State Government amounted to seven-seven billion, four hundred one million, one hundred and three thousand, eight hundred twenty three naira, forty-five kobo (\rightarrow 77,401,103,823.45), representing 52.49% of the budgeted receipt of one hundred and forty seven billion, four hundred and sixty million, one hundred and one thousand, eight hundred and eighty nine naira, sixty five kobo (\rightarrow 147,460,101,889.65) for the year.

The Short Term Loan reported in the Statement of Financial Position amounting to eight hundred and seventy one million, eight hundred and twenty five thousand naira (N871,825,000.00) represents advances to the 13 Local Government Councils of the State for on-lending to farmers in their respective councils. 5.1.1. 2019 Budget Performance from FAAC and Sources Outside the State Government on Cash Basis IPSAS

The State made budget provisions to receive from NNPC Refund of three hundred million naira (\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{million}}}}}}} \text{ naira (\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{million}}}}}}, and Police Reform; five hundred million naira (N500,000,000.00) but had a nil receipt. While budget provisions were not made for the following, yet the State the attached the items: received various amounts as to Forex Equalization; two hundred and sixty eight million, two hundred and fifty six thousand, five hundred and fifty three naira, ninety four kobo (N268,256,553.94), Excess Bank Charges Refund; one hundred and twenty-six million, eight hundred and twenty-one thousand, eight hundred and ninety-nine naira, fifty-three kobo (₹126,821,899.53). Derivative from Solid Mineral; thirty nine million eight hundred twenty eight thousand, one hundred and eighty four naira (N39,828,184.00), and Gross Allocation; forty seven million, seven hundred and fifteen thousand seven hundred ten naira, twenty six kobo (N47,715,710.26).

However, the underlisted share of FAAC Allocations were budgeted for and got below the expectations except Paris Club Refund. They are:

The implication of the above is that the receipt from Paris Club Refund was much more than the expected receipt with 1,242% increase, while receipts from Statutory Allocation, Value Added Tax (VAT) were above average of 66% and 67% respectively, and receipts from Exchange Rate Gain, Excess Crude, and Augmented Fund Distribution were abysmal with a 3%, 7% and 5% respectively and appear to have had overestimated budgetary allocation.

In all, the State received fifty four billion, eight hundred and twenty nine million, four hundred and seventy-two thousand, four hundred and seventy-five naira, twenty-seven kobo (\H54,829,472,475.27) out of an expected budget provision of eighty one billion, one hundred and sixty million, one hundred and one thousand, eight hundred and ninety six naira, sixty five kobo (\H81,160,101,896.65). This shows a shortfall of twenty-six billion, three hundred and thirty million, six hundred and twenty nine thousand, four hundred and twenty-one naira, thirty-eight kobo (\H26,330,629,421.38) or 62% performance.

5.1.2. Internally Generated Revenue Budget Performance by Sector

Out of a total Budget provision of twenty eight billion naira (\$\frac{1}{2}28,000,000,000.000.000) for Internally Generated Revenue, only twenty billion, five hundred and sixty-six million, one hundred and ninety-three thousand, twenty naira, forty six kobo (\$\frac{1}{2}20,566,193,020.46) was actualized. This shows a shortfall, in Internally Generated Revenue, of seven billion, four hundred and thirty-three million, eight hundred and six thousand, nine hundred and seventy nine naira, fifty four kobo (\$\frac{1}{2}7,433,806,979.54) or 73% performance and 27% shortfall. The variances analyses of the various sub-heads highlight as indicated in Table 1.

Taxes generated five billion, two hundred and fifty eight million, four hundred and two thousand, seven hundred and eighty four naira, thirty six kobo (₹5,258,402,784.36) thereby over shooting the Budget provision of three billion, three hundred and seventy three million, sixty three thousand, twenty five naira, twenty nine kobo (₹3,373,063,025.29) with one billion, eight hundred and eighty five million, three hundred and thirty nine thousand, seven hundred and fifty nine naira, seven kobo (₹1,885,339,759.07) which shows a 56% increase.

Licences also performed over and above the Budget figure. While one hundred and four million, five hundred and forty nine thousand, three hundred naira (\mathbb{H}104,549,300.00) was budgeted for it, it generated two hundred and twenty four million, nine hundred and seventy four thousand, six hundred and twenty two naira, eleven kobo (\mathbb{H}224,974,622.11) showing over performance of one hundred and twenty million, four hundred and twenty five thousand, three hundred and twenty two naira, eleven kobo (\mathbb{H}120,425,322.11) or 115% increase. Unfortunately, Fines, Fees Sales, Earnings, Rent, Interest Earned, Investment Income, and Other Revenues could not meet the amounts the Budget set for them:

Fines had an abysmal performance of twelve million, nine hundred and seventy nine thousand, eight hundred and thirty one naira, seventy one kobo (\frac{12,979,831.71}{12,979,831.71}) as against the Budget's projected figure of two hundred and seventeen million, eight hundred and fifteen thousand naira (\frac{12,7815,000.00}{12,000.00}) with a shortfall of two hundred and four million, eight hundred thirty five thousand, one hundred and sixty eight naira, twenty nine kobo (\frac{12,04,835,168.29}{12,000.00}) or 5.96% performance.

Fees contributed three billion, five hundred and thirty nine million, nine hundred and sixty three thousand, seventy six naira, nine kobo (\frac{1}{2}3,539,963,076.09), while the budgeted figure is five billion, one hundred thirty two million, nine hundred and fifty eight thousand, four hundred and ninety one naira (\frac{1}{2}5,130,958,491.00) showing a difference of one billion, five hundred and ninety million, nine hundred and ninety five thousand, four hundred and fourteen naira, ninety one kobo(\frac{1}{2}1,590,995,414.91) or 69% performance.

Sales generated six hundred and thirty nine million, one hundred and eighty one thousand, four hundred and fifty nine naira, fifty three kobo (\mathbb{H}639,181,459.53) out of a budget figure of four billion, five hundred and twenty five million, five hundred and seventy two thousand, seven hundred and fourteen naira (\mathbb{H}4,525,572,714.00) showing a shortfall of three billion, four hundred and sixty naira, eight hundred and eighteen thousand, five hundred and forty naira, forty seven kobo (\mathbb{H}3,886,391,254.47) with a 14.12% performance.

Earnings had a budget figure of nine hundred and seventy nine million, six hundred and seventy one thousand naira (N979,671,000.00) but generated only eighty two million, six hundred and sixteen thousand, seven hundred and thirty one naira (N82,616,731.00) with a shortfall of eight hundred and ninety seven million, fifty-four thousand, two hundred and sixty nine naira (N897,054,269.00) or 8.43% performance.

Rent had forty five million, nine hundred and sixty naira (¥45,960,000.00) budgeted for it but had a performance of seventeen million, one hundred and twelve thousand seven hundred and eighty naira (¥17,112,780.00) with a shortfall of twenty eight million, eight hundred and forty seven thousand, two hundred and twenty naira (¥28,847,220.00) or 37.23% performance.

Interest Earned generated one billion, one hundred and thirty two million, three hundred and sixty seven thousand, six hundred and thirty seven naira, seven kobo (\mathbb{N}1,132,367,637.07) while its Budget figure was three billion, five hundred million naira (\mathbb{N}2,422,604,380.00) with a deficit of one billion, two hundred and nine million, two hundred and thirty six thousand, seven hundred and forty two naira ninety three kobo (\mathbb{N}1,290,236,742.93) or 46.74% budget performance.

Investment Income had fifty two million naira (\mathbb{N}52,000,000.00) budget figure but generated seventeen million, three hundred and thirty two thousand, seven hundred and ninety nine naira, sixty kobo (\mathbb{N}17,332,799.60) with a deficit of thirty four million, six hundred and sixty seven thousand, two hundred naira, forty kobo (\mathbb{N}34,667,200.40) or 33%.

Other Revenues generated two hundred and eighty nine million, seven hundred and eighty two thousand, three hundred and sixty two naira, eighteen kobo (¥289,782,362.18) as against the Budgeted figure of one billion and one hundred forty seven million, seven hundred and fourteen thousand, five hundred and eighty nine naira, seven one kobo (¥1,147,714,589.71) or a shortfall of eight hundred and fifty six million, nine hundred and thirty two thousand, two hundred and twenty seven naira, eighty three kobo (¥856,932,227.53) or 25.25%.

5.2. RECURRENT AND CAPITAL EXPENDITURE BY SECTOR BUDGET PERFORMANCE

Sectorally, most of both the Recurrent and Capital Expenditures in all the items of expenditures were less than their budget estimates. Public Debt Repayment exceeded the budget figure by three billion, eight hundred thirty nine million, seven hundred and forty thousand, seven hundred seventy seven naira, fifty-six kobo (¥3,839,740,777.56) as four hundred million naira (¥400,000,000.00) was budgeted for Public Debt Repayment while four billion, two hundred and thirty nine million, seven hundred and forty thousand, seven hundred and seventy seven naira, fifty-six kobo (¥4,239,740,777.56) was actually paid in 2019. An indication that there was budget discipline in the year 2019. Details of both the Recurrent and Capital Expenditure by Sector are as shown in Table 1 above.

5.2.1 Recurrent Expenditure Budget Performance by Sector

In all, a total of Recurrent Expenditure Budget of thirty billion, eight hundred and eighty-nine million, two hundred and sixty-two thousand, five hundred and forty five naira, thirty-one kobo (\frac{1}{2}35,889,262,545.31) by sector, only thirty billion, two hundred and thirty-eighty million, two hundred and one thousand, four hundred and twenty naira, thirty-six kobo (\frac{1}{2}30,238,201,420.36) only was incurred sectorally, leaving five billion, six hundred and fifty-one million, sixty-one thousand, one hundred and twenty-four naira, ninety-five kobo (\frac{1}{2}5,651,061,124.95) unspent.

5.2.2. Capital Expenditure by Sector Budget Performance

Likewise, each of the sectors of the Capital Expenditure spent less than their budget provisions. In aggregate, the five sectors spent thirty-nine billion, seven hundred eighty-two million, two hundred and eighty-seven thousand, one hundred seventy-four naira, sixty-two kobo (¥39,782,287,174.62) out of the budget provision of one hundred and forty-one billion, six hundred and eighty-one million, six hundred and seventy thousand naira (¥141,681,670,000.00).

5.3.1 2019 Share of FAAC Allocations Comparison with 2018 Performance on Cash Basis

A total of fifty four billion, eight hundred and four twenty million, seventy five thousand, nine hundred and ninety one naira, seventy kobo (\(\frac{854}{824}\),075,991.70) was received in 2019 under Cash Basis IPSAS Accounting as against the 2018 receipt of fifty seven billion, five hundred and thirty four million, eight hundred and ninety two thousand, six hundred and ninety naira, twenty nine kobo (\(\frac{857}{854}\),892,690.29). These show that the State received less than what she received in 2018 from Share of FAAC Allocations by three billion, two hundred and ten million, eight hundred and sixteen thousand, six hundred ninety eight naira, fifty nine kobo (\(\frac{83}{83}\),210,816,698.59) as contained in Table 2 above.

5.3.2. Internally Generated Revenue (IGR) Comparison with 2018 Performance by Sector on Cash Basis

Apart from Earnings and Investment Income, the State performed better in 2019 than 2018 in all the other IGR sub-heads such as Taxes, Licences, Fines, Fees, Sales, Reimbursements, Rent, Interest Earned, and Other Revenues. See Table 2.

5.3.3. Recurrent Expenditure Comparison with 2018 Performance by Sector on Cash Basis

In 2019, the State spent less in the following sectors: Personnel Cost, Programme related Expenses, Social Benefit, Overhead Subvention to Parastatals, and Public Debt Repayments while she spent more on: Overhead Cost and Service Wide Vote compared to the 2018 Recurrent Expenditure by Sector on Cash Basis IPSAS as contained in Table 2.

5.3.4. Capital Expenditure Comparison with 2018 Performance by Sector in Cash Basis

In the Capital Expenditure prepared on Cash Basis IPSAS, the State spent less in three Sectors: Administrative, Economic, and Law and Justice but spent more in the Social Sector in 2019 as against those of 2018. In Regional Sector where there was no budgetary provision in 2018, the State spent one hundred and seventeen million, twenty six thousand, one hundred and seventeen million, twenty six thousand, one hundred and thirty naira (\mathbb{N}117,026,130.00) in 2019. IPSAS 33 requires that recognition and/or measurement of Assets/Liabilities can be recognized for reporting within 3 years following the date of adoption. Ebonyi State Government adopted Accrual Basis IPSAS in 1st January, 2016 and has recognized and/or measured all Assets/Liabilities in the 2018 Financial Statements.

ACCOUNTING AND REPORTING

All responsibilities bestowed on me as listed below have been fulfilled:

- a. Ensuring that adequate system of internal controls are maintained to safeguard assets and provide reasonable assurance that the transactions as recorded are within statutory authority; and also that the use of all public financial resources by the Government are properly recorded.
- b. Ensuring that proper books and records of accounts were kept to ensure that the Financial Statements reflect the financial position of Ebonyi State Government and its operations for the year ended 31st December, 2019.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Following the adoption of the International Public Sector Accounting Standard (IPSAS) in Nigeria and National Chart of Accounts (NCOA, a standardized format of General Purpose Financial Statements (GPFS) have been designed and introduced for adoption by Ebonyi State Government. For effective and efficient use of the NCOA and GPFS, the accounting policies for IPSAS accrual basis accounting have been developed as a tool to direct the processes and procedures relating to financial reporting in Ebonyi State.

The General Purpose Financial Statements include:

- i. Consolidated Statement of Financial Performance
- ii. Consolidated Statement of Financial Position
- iii. Consolidated Statement of Net Assets/Equity
- iv. Consolidated Statement of Cash Flow
- v. Consolidated Statement of Budget Comparison and Actual
- vi. Consolidated Segment Reporting
- vii. Notes to the Consolidated Financial Statements.
- Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements: The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with International Public Sector Accounting standards (IPSAS). Accrual basis concept is the basis of preparation of all accounts by all reporting entities in Ebonyi State.
- 2. **Accounting Period**: The accounting period (Fiscal Year) is from 1st January to 31st December. Each accounting year is divided into 12 calendar months and it is set up as such in the accounting system of the State.
- Reporting Currency: The Reporting currency in preparation of General Purpose Financial Statements is Nigeria Naira.
- 4. **Consolidation of Financial Statements**: The consolidation of General Purpose Financial Statements is based on the financial transactions of all Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) of the State Government. Government Business Entities (GBEs) are not included in the consolidations. Controlled Entities are fully consolidated from the date on which control is acquired.

- 5. **Notes to the Financial Statements:** Notes to the Financial Statements are presented in a manner that they cross reference to any related information in the Financial Statements.
- 6. **Comparative Information**: The General Purpose Financial Statements (GPFs) are designed to show all numerical information relating to previous year(s).
- 7. **Budget Figures:** A Statement of Comparison of Budget and Actual Amount is prepared for the determination of items of revenue and expenditure in respect to budgetary provisions. IPSAS 24 requires an entity to present a comparison of budget amount for which it is held publicly accountable and actual amount either as a separate additional Financial Statement or as additional budget columns in the financial statements. Ebonyi State Government opted for the former.
- 8. **Revenues**: Ebonyi State recognizes revenues from non-exchange transactions such as fees, taxes and fines when the event occurs and the asset recognition criteria are met. Other non-exchange revenues are recognized when it is probable that the future economic benefits or service potential associated with the asset will flow to the entity and the fair value can be measured reliably. Revenue from the sales of goods and services is recognized when significant risks and rewards of ownership has been transferred to the buyer. Similarly, gain on disposal of Property, Plant and Equipment (PP&E) is recognized at the date control of the asset is passed to the buyer.
- 9. **Aid and Grants**: Aid and Grants to Ebonyi State Government are recognized as incomes on entitlement, while Aid and Grants to other Government or Agencies are recognized as expenditure on commitment. Counterpart Contributions to World Bank funded Agencies are also recognized as expenditures.
- 10. **Expenditures:** Expenditures are classified as either recurrent or capital. All recurrent expenditures are reported on an accrual basis (ie they are recognized in the period they are incurred or when the related services are enjoyed, irrespective of when the payment is made). Recurrent Expenditures are reported in the Statement of Financial Performance. Payments for purchase of items of Capital nature (PP&E) are treated as Assets under Non-Current Assets in the Statement of Financial Position. At the end of the financial year, a schedule of PP&E is prepared as part of the Notes to GPFs.

- 11. **Assets under Construction** are not depreciated until the constructions are completed. Under construction assets acquired within a year are included in the schedule of PP&E for that year.
- 12. **Property, Plant and Equipment (PP&E):** Property, Plant and Equipment (PP&E)include:
 - i. Building
 - ii. Infrastructure- Water
 - iii. Infrastructure- Other
 - iv. Plants & Machinery
 - v. Furniture & Fittings
 - vi. Motor Vehicles
 - vii. Office and other equipment
 - viii. IT equipment

Infrastructure - Water assets include Boreholes, Dams and water pipes while Infrastructure-Others assets include road networks, electrification and bridges.

13. **Depreciation/Amortization:** the following depreciation/amortization rates apply:

- 14. **Capitalization:** The capitalization threshold is One Hundred Thousand Naira (N100,000.00) and above. Only amount spent in connection with PP&E and Intangibles and whose values exceed One Hundred Thousand Naira (N100,000.00) is capitalized. Non Current assets whose costs are below the capitalization threshold are charged appropriately to the Statement of Financial Performance.
- 15. **Statement of Cash Flow:** Statement of Cash Flow is prepared using the direct method. The cash flow consists:
 - i. Operating activities
 - ii. Investing activities
 - iii. Financing activities
- 16. Cash and Cash Equivalent: Cash and Cash Equivalent are cash balance on hand, held in bank accounts, demand deposits and other highly liquid investments with an original maturity of 6 months or less in which Ebonyi State invests as part of its day-to-day cash management and which are readily convertible to known amount of cash and are subject to insignificant risk of changes in value. Cash and Cash Equivalent is reported under Current Asset in the Statement of Financial Position.

17. Receivables:

- a. Receivables from exchange transactions are recognized initially at fair value and subsequently measured at amortized cost less provision for impairment
- b. Receivables from non-exchange transactions are initially assessed at nominal amount or face value and subsequently adjusted for impairment.
- 18. Loans: Loans granted to other Government, agencies or individuals are shown separately in the Statement of Financial Position.
- 19. Investments: Investments made in government stock, quoted companies etc are disclosed as Financial Assets in the Statement of Financial Position.
- 20. **Transfer from Other Government Entities**: Transfer from other government entities are non-exchange items and are recognized as revenue in the Statement of Financial Performance.

21. **Transfer to Other Government Entities**: Transfer to other government entities are non-exchange items and are recognized as expenses in the Statement of Financial Performance.

22. **Borrowing Costs:** Borrowing Costs are capitalized against qualifying assets as part of PPSE. Such borrowing costs are capitalized over the period during which the asset is being acquired or constructed and borrowings have been incurred. Other borrowing costs not capitalized are charged to statement of Financial Performance.

23. **Foreign Currency:** Foreign Currency transactions are translated into Naira, the reporting currency, using the spot rate as at last day of the financial year.

24. **Contingency Fund:** Capital and recurrent expenditures that were not captured in the budget of MDAs are charged to contingency fund domiciled in the Office of the Accountant-General.
